

## The Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996

### **Lewes District Council Dogs (Fouling of Land) (No.1) Order 2005**

The Lewes District Council (in this Order called "the Council") hereby make the following Order:

1. The land described in the Schedule below being land in the area of the Council which is land to which the Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996 applies, is hereby designated for the purposes of that Act.
2. This Order may be cited as the Lewes District Council Dogs (Fouling of Land) (No.1) Order 2005 and shall come into force on **18 JULY 2005**

#### **SCHEDULE**

Any land within the administrative boundary of the Council which is open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access with or without payment but excluding those areas described and defined in sections 1(3) and (6) of the Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996 namely:-

- land used for agriculture or for woodlands
- land which is predominantly marshland, moor or heath; and
- common land to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access otherwise than by virtue of section 193(1) of the Law of Property Act 1925 (right of access to urban common land)
