The series of byelaws with respect to Pleasure Grounds which was made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Eastbourne, acting by the Council, on the sixth day of June, 1921, and was allowed by the Minister of Health on the fifteenth day of August, 1921, shall be read and have effect as if the following byelaws were inserted after byelaw No. 29 thereof:

- 29(a). A person shall not in the pleasure ground for purpose of gain or reward
- (i) Solicit any person for the purpose of taking any photograph;
 - (ii) Without the consent of the Council take any photographs of any person.
