

# **EASTBOURNE EMPLOYMENT LAND LOCAL PLAN**

## **Adoption Statement**

### **Town & Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012**

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 that the Eastbourne Employment Land Local Plan was formally adopted by Eastbourne Borough Council on **Wednesday 16 November 2016**.

The Eastbourne Employment Land Local Plan was considered by an independent Inspector as part of an Examination in Public, with hearing sessions held on 12 May, 13 May and 30 June 2016. The Inspectors' report was published on 25 October 2016 and concluded that the Eastbourne Employment Local Plan was 'sound', subject to a number of required modifications. These modifications are set out in the Inspectors Report.

Any person aggrieved by the decision to adopt the Eastbourne Employment Land Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended). Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 6 weeks after the date of adoption (i.e. Wednesday 28 December 2016).

Any challenge to this decision must be made on the grounds that the document has not been made in accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or alternatively that a requirement of the Act or associated Regulations have not been complied with.

In accordance with Regulation 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, the Eastbourne Employment Land Local Plan and its associated Consultation Statement, Adoption Statement, the Inspectors Report and Sustainability Appraisal report, have been made available for inspection during normal office hours at: Eastbourne Borough Council, 1 Grove Road, Eastbourne, East Sussex, BN21 4TW
