I am responsible for ensuring the Council's priorities and services are based on customer insight and needs. I work with partners in the Lewes District Community Safety

Partnership (including Sussex Police and East Sussex Fire and Rescue) to ensure we remain a safe place to live, work and visit. I also take the lead the delivery of customer services, leisure services and tourism.

Key Priorities and Projects

- Liaise with Town and Parish Councils, including enabling devolution of open spaces to Town and Parish Councils.
- Attend Town and Parish Council meetings to update them on council and district matters

- Oversee provision of District car parks and other facilities.
- In partnership, reduce anti-social behaviour and tackle crime hotspots, in line with the Community Safety Partnership Plan for the Lewes District.
- Deliver a new mobile and flexible approach to tourism across the District.
- Ensure the key channels that our customers use to contact the Council including the call centre and website all operate to meet demand.
- Ensure the delivery of the district wide Leisure Strategy in partnership with Wave Leisure.
- Work with the Community and Voluntary Sector including provision of grants to key organisations
- Work with health partners to promote wellbeing.
- Ensure the JTP improves services for customers whilst reducing costs.
