If the frequency of street cleaning has reduced since 2010 due to cuts to funding?

The contract currently in place (since 2013) is outcome based and follows the standards in the Defra code of practice for litter and refuse (NI195). The indicative frequencies noted in the contract have remained constant for about the past 10 years.

How many people in your local authority deliver street cleaning services in each year since 2010?

The service is contracted- there are no staff directly employed by the council that carry out litter picking of the highway.

How many miles of road in your local authority have been cleaned on average each week in each year since 2010?

Please see point 2. The "miles cleaned" varies depending on need- but it averages around 200.

The number of complaints that have been received by your local authority in relation to street cleaning in each year since 2010?

Since 2013 (data not available prior to this date) we have received 1642 complaints for all services related to the waste, recycling and street

cleansing contract. Information is not presented in a way so as to allow the service areas to be split out.
