I have responsibility for ensuring we deliver our regeneration ambitions for the District through our strategic development portfolio.

We will continue to work with a range of

public and private sector partners to secure investment, growth and support for our businesses.

I will work within the wider sub region to ensure Lewes is well positioned in discussions with Government and Local Enterprise Partnerships.

Key Priorities

- Ensure the Enterprise Zone in Newhaven delivers its target of 2,000 jobs and 70,000 sq metres of new and refurbished employment floor-space.
- Work with partners to deliver a regenerated town centre in Newhaven and Railway Quay.
- Work with Joint Venture, Clear Futures, to deliver 416 homes, 475 new jobs, 140,000 sq metres of commercial space, flood defences and over 300 public car parking spaces in North Street Quarter in Lewes.
- Create a blue light services hub that supports delivery of the North Street Quarter.
- Deliver a new health hub in Seaford.
- Delivery new housing through modular housing; developing infill sites and through a community land trust.
- Ensure delivery of a pipeline of projects across the district that can be delivered through the CLEAR Futures Joint Venture and that can utilise Government funding to deliver growth
