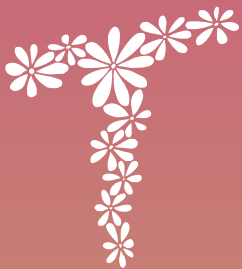


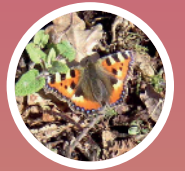
Let's celebrate World Environment Day on 5th June and see what can be found in your local environment

Hunting high and low, and far and wide in the glorious outdoors where the wild things grow, can you find nature and wildlife beginning with the letters of the acrostic?

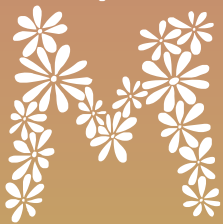
A few examples are given for each letter to help you on your search and adventures – be sure to add in ones that you find and see yourselves!
