The surplus on the parking account pays for any parking improvement projects and supports the council's general expenditure.

The total income of £984,000 shown in the table above comes wholly from the council's off-street parking activities, i.e. from car parks.

The council receives no income from any on-street parking activities, i.e. from charging for parking on highways and roads. In Lewes on-street parking is operated by East Sussex County Council.

Because the council operates off-street parking only it is exempt from the legislative requirements of Section 55 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to ring fence any surplus and apply it solely for highways and transport related purposes.
