Lewes Local Plan Part 2 Examination, 2-12 April 2019

Seaford Town Council has previously submitted a consultation response on land at East Quay, Newhaven identified as E1 in the Draft Local Plan Part 2 [REP/016/E1]. We are the adjoining town and share the extensive beach front known as Seaford Bay. One of our councillors, Cllr. Penny Lower, has worked with members of Community Action Newhaven who have provided a large amount of evidence addressing the matters identified by the Inspector.

Cllr. Lower has consulted with the Planning Committee at STC on issues with specific negative impacts on Seaford: the need to protect SDNP, adjoining Nature Reserves and the heritage site at Tide Mills; the potential environmental damage to the bay area: loss of amenity to local residents [Matters 5, 6, 10].

As we are advised that it is not appropriate to submit duplicate evidence, we wish to confirm that we fully support the detailed submissions now presented to you by Community Action Newhaven and Newhaven Town Council, especially as they relate the issues identified above.
