Dear Chris

Further to my email earlier today, I was eventually contacted by Veolia from the Recycling Centre adjacent to the Maresfield Gypsy and Traveller site regarding the fencing on the boundary. They said that they could not allow me to photograph it but that there is concrete and metal galvanised fencing 2.4 meters high on the north, south and west sides. (The Gypsy and Traveller Site is on the south side). In addition to this there is high acoustic fencing then bunding and trees planted on the Recycling Centre side. There is high close-boarded fencing on the east side. Also metal gates on the north side which are padlocked at night.

Despite all this they say that they have had a fair bit of trouble from the Gypsy and Traveller Site with break-ins, thefts of fuel, damage and antisocial behaviour. They have had to up their security with more lighting and more security cameras.

All this makes me distinctly nervous.
