Adoption Statement

Lewes District Local Plan Part 1: Joint Core Strategy

Notice is hereby given that Lewes District Council adopted the Lewes District Local Plan Part 1: Joint Core Strategy on 11 May 2016 in accordance with the above regulations.

The Lewes District Local Plan Part 1: Joint Core Strategy replaces some of the 'saved' policies of the Lewes District Local Plan 2003. The 'saved' policies that are replaced or retained are set out in Appendix 2 of the Lewes District Local Plan Part 1: Joint Core Strategy.

The Lewes District Local Plan Part 1: Joint Core Strategy sets out the overarching planning framework for the district to 2030, including the Vision for development and change in the district, Strategic Objectives and the Spatial Strategy. It also contains Core Delivery Policies and a Monitoring Framework.

The Lewes District Local Plan Part 1: Joint Core Strategy has been subject to examination² by an independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The adopted Plan incorporates the Main Modifications recommended by the Inspector as set out in the Appendix³ to the Inspector's Final Report, as well as Additional Modifications made by the Council.

Copies of this Adoption Statement, the Adopted Lewes District Local Plan Part 1: Joint Core Strategy, Policies Maps, Sustainability Appraisal incorporating Strategic Environmental Assessment, post-adoption Environmental Statement, Inspector's Final Report and other associated documents are available at www.lewes.gov.uk/corestrategy. Paper copies are also available to view (free of charge) at the Council's principal office at Southover House, Southover Road, Lewes, BN7 1AB (Mon – Fri 9am to 5 pm). In addition, each library in the district will be supplied with a copy of the Joint Core Strategy, including policies maps.

Any person who is aggrieved by the Lewes District Local Plan Part 1: Joint Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or procedural requirements have not been complied with. Any such application should be made promptly and in any event no later than the end of the period of six weeks starting from the date on which the Plan was adopted i.e. no later than 22 June 2016.
