WHEREAS Eastbourne Borough Council being the appropriate Local Planning Authority within the meaning of article 4(5) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development)(England) Order 2015 is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out on the land shown edged red on the attached plan , unless planning permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).



SCHEDULE 1

Development consisting of a change of use of a building from a use falling with Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 to a use falling within Class 4 (houses in multiple occupation) of that Schedule and not being development comprised within any other Class.
