

ACCESS STATEMENT SUMMARY

Find Out if Long Park Corner Children's Play Area is accessible for you

Where to find the play area

Long Park Corner is located in the village of Ditchling with public transport by bus a short walk. The accessible entrance to the play area is from Long Park Corner, Ditchling BN6 8UX.



Where to Park

There is no allocated parking, it is on the street parking only. There are no disabled parking bays.

Getting from the car park to the children's play area

To get to the play area from main entrance, you can follow a short tarmac surface path which leads to the play equipment. This is on a slight incline with three steps before the gate. There is an additional entrance with no steps on a slight incline.

Getting into the children's play area

There are accessible entrances into the play area, with the opening measuring in excess of 1000mm wide. The gates are bright yellow in colour and are opened by hand. The area is accessible to service dogs.

Getting around the children's play area

The playground surface is accessible and made up grass, concrete and bark. It is uneven in places.

There is a small range of different play apparatus. The play space appeals to most senses, it offers an adequate selection of equipment providing lots of textures and patterns.



Seating

There is one wooden bench seat and a metal picnic style table and bench seats.



Toilets

There are no toilets nearby.
