

## English Language Test Guidance

All new applicants for a Drivers Licence will be required to undergo a proficiency test to demonstrate their ability to communicate effectively in the English Language.

Online Assessments allow you the convenience of taking of the test remotely from your own computer. These assessments are proctored online, to ensure the integrity of the test, and to ensure fairness. Remote Proctoring allows us to monitor your entire session using your Camera, Microphone and Browser. Your session will get recorded and analysed, via automated and manual means to detect any fraudulent or suspicious behaviour.

Candidates found practicing any suspicious activities during the test will be disqualified & retesting will be at the applicant's cost. Any person found cheating will be disqualified and will not be granted a licence for at least three years.

### System requirements to attend the test.

- Machine: Only use a laptop/desktop. **DO NOT** use a mobile device.
- Video/Audio: Webcam and a good quality Wired Mic is required.
- Operating system: Windows 8 or 10, Mac OS X 10.9 Mavericks or Higher.
- Browser: Only Google Chrome version 100 & above, with cookies & popups enabled
- Internet Connection: Stable 2 Mbps or more. Try using Broadband.

### Things to do right before the test

- Make sure you are in a quiet room
- Make sure that no one else is present in the room
- Make sure that your phone is on silent mode
- Make sure that your computer is connected to the power supply
- Make sure that you have a stable Internet connection of 2Mbps+. Please try to use a broadband connection & avoid unstable 3G/4G networks.
- Make sure that your face is well-lit and clearly visible in the camera
- Make sure that you are using a USB headset with microphone for the test

### Things to do during the test

- Make sure that you complete the test in a single go
- Do not take breaks during the test
- Make sure your face & mouth are always visible in the camera throughout the test
- Make sure you are not taking any external help throughout the test
