

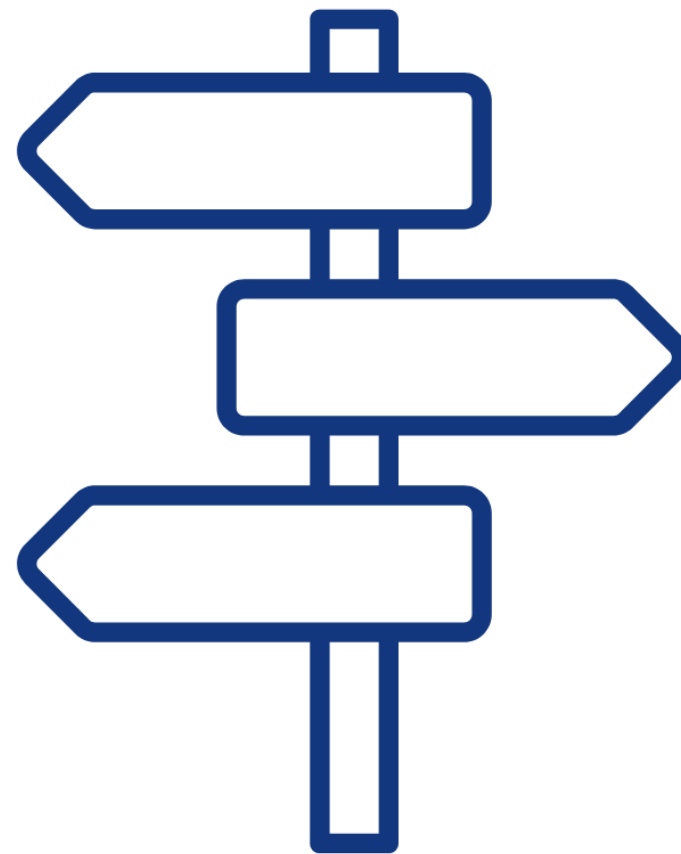

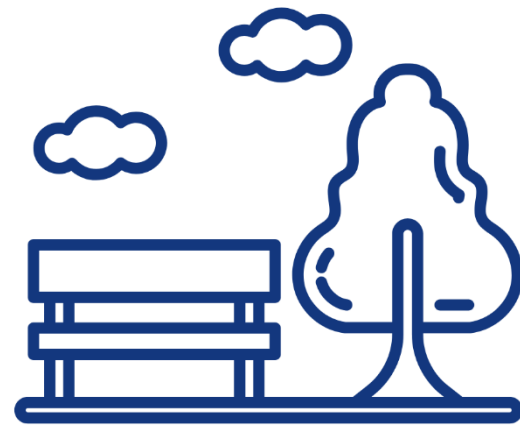

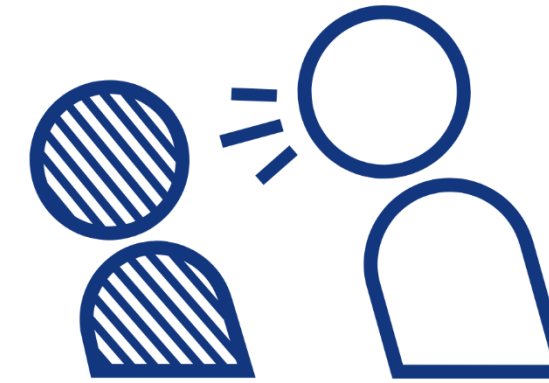

Supporting the street community



Promoting road safety

Working alongside local police teams to reduce crime and anti-social behaviour through:

- Additional police patrols targeting crime hotspots
- Installing lighting on the seafront
- Renewing CCTV systems
- Tackling shoplifting
- Supporting Street pastors creating weekend safe space
- Funding referrals to mediation services
- Council led patch-based patrols



Addressing the impact of organised crime through:

- Supporting youth diversion projects
- Sharing intelligence within the Organised crime Partnership
- Protecting vulnerable residents from criminal gangs
- Op Discovery – tackling exploitation and modern slavery
- Campaign on the harm of drugs
- Campaigns to raise awareness of fraud



Reducing violent crime through:

- Engaging young people in art, music and sports projects
- Hotspot patrols in places with higher rates of crime
- Taking part in place-based initiatives
- Working with East Sussex County Council to provide a youth club offer
- Supporting night-time marshals



Tackling hate crime and violence against women and girls through:

- Funding local projects
- Working with Sussex Police to support victims of hate crime
- Promoting community cohesion
- Promoting ESCC commissioned support services on our website
- Raising awareness at local events
- Delivering specialist support to victims at risk of homelessness



Supporting the street community and tackling related anti-social behaviour through:

- Working with the Council's housing team to secure accommodation
- Enforcing alcohol bans on street drinking in the town centre
- Co-ordinating the work of agencies to conduct twice weekly outreach visits
- Funding a weekend day centre for street community
- Partnering with commissioned drug and alcohol support services



Promoting road safety through:

- Funding local Speedwatch groups
- Enforcing the Anti-Social Driving Public Spaces Protection Order
- Supporting Op Downsway to help tackle speeding and dangerous driving
- Identifying local speeding hotspots
