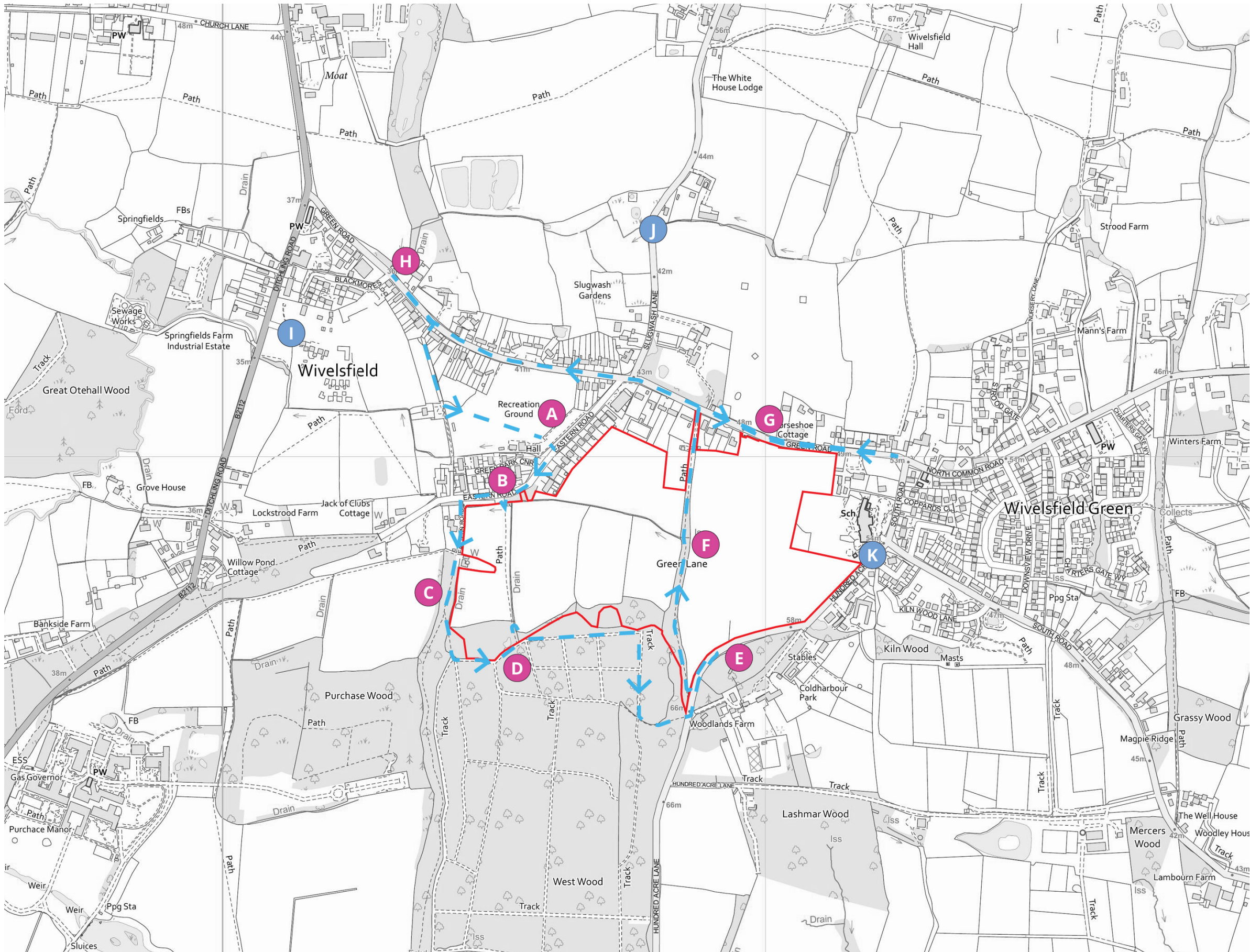




Key

NOTES:

The suggested walking route will pass various points and viewpoints referred to by both the Appellants landscape witness and those of the LDC landscape witness. Stops in addition to those shown on this itinerary can be made along the route, where these are considered relevant.

Suggested accompanied route:

- A. Meeting point: Wivelsfield Village Hall car park (RH17 7QH).
 - B. Eastern Road (Sussex Border Path): Walk road, review site, refer to Mr Atkin Viewpoint 8.
 - C. Bridleway WSM/28/2 (Sussex Border Path): Walk along bridleway, review site, stop at Mr Hird's viewpoint.
 - D. West Wood: Review site from woodland edge, including public footpath WSM/1/1, refer to Mr Atkin Viewpoints 11 & 12.
 - E. Hundred Acre Lane: Review LGS, refer to Mr Atkin Viewpoint 14.
 - F. Green Lane (public bridleway WIV/30/1): Review site from bridleway (including access), refer to Mr Atkin Viewpoint 10. Stop at Mr Hird's viewpoint.
 - G. Green Road: Review eastern site area, including reference to war memorial (refer to Mr Hird's viewpoint), separation, LGS, Area of Established Character. Refer to Mr Atkin Viewpoint 9.
 - H. Green Road: Review existing settlement pattern / character. Refer to Mr Atkin Viewpoints 6 & 7. Return to starting point via public footpath WIV/11/1 and recreation ground, refer to Mr Atkin Viewpoint 5.
- Suggested unaccompanied points:
- I. Cala development: Consider settlement pattern / character, retained green infrastructure.
 - J. Slugwash Lane / Sussex Border Path: Consider rural character and transition to settlement.
 - K. Hundred Acre Lane / Wivelsfield Primary School: Review eastern site area (Mr Hird's viewpoint), consider LGS.
